You are responsible for adding it to your current schedule. Attendance Policy

Attendance at ALL performances is required for membership in the band program. Absences are permitted in the event of extenuating circumstances (i.e. personal illness, death in the family). Excessive absences, even for these reasons, will make it extremely difficult for a student to learn the material and prepare for performances.

All necessary absences should be presented in writing in advance, if possible. Failure to appear at a scheduled performance without proper notice in advance will result in a “0” grade for that performance. It is impossible to “make up a performance” and the other members must carry an extra burden because of someone else’s inconsideration. Extenuating circumstances should be discussed with the director prior to the event. Performance dates are given in the beginning of the school year and plans should be made around them. Please remember that having a job is NOT an excused absence from any performance. Band members who work should take their band schedule to their employer and request not to be scheduled to work on these days.

Absence Policy

A list of required performances for the year is provided for each student to help prevent potential scheduling conflicts with your family activities. However, I realize and understand that there are certain circumstances that could prevent some students from attending a scheduled event (i.e. personal illness, death in the family). Under these circumstances, I will consider the absence EXCUSED and will result in a “no grade.” **All excused absences should be presented in writing in advance**, if possible. Absences for any other reason will be UNEXCUSED. Any unexcused absence from a performance will result in a “0” grade for that performance. We all want to be successful this year. If you choose to skip performances, the rest of the band suffers.

Grading Policy

In-Class Participation – 45%

This includes timeliness, level of preparedness, practicing, and having all your materials. When the bell rings, you have 4 minutes to get your materials together, warm-up, and be ready to play. Rehearsals are not the time for you to practice. Practice outside of class so that you are prepared prior to rehearsals.

Performances – 40%

See the attendance and absence policies

Tests – 10%

Playing and chair placement tests will contribute to this portion of your grade.

Assignments – 5%

Assignments will consist of taking important information home, reading it over with your parents, and returning it to class signed and dated.
